

**Request for Proposal – Yankie Street Project**  
**Permanent Outdoor Placemaking Mural**  
**Submittal deadline: July 25, 2022**

**About the Project**

The Yankie Street Project is a placemaking project titled, “Why are the Sidewalks so High?” that includes historic images of flooding at the corner of Yankie and Bullard Streets and includes the placemaking activities of checkers and picnicking.

The goal of the project is to educate about our flood history, activate the space, and provide a space for intergenerational activities.

**Mural Specifications and Information**

The placemaking murals will consist of 4 paintings  
(2) 20 inch by 20 inch painted checker boards  
(2) approximately 30 inch by 30 inch painted table cloths that indicate a place to picnic.  
A coating to protect the surface of the murals.

The location is the retaining wall on the south side of the dead end of Yankie Street at the corner of Bullard Street. The 2 checker boards would be on the west end of the retaining wall and the table cloths towards the east side.

Funding for this project is \$750 to include artist fee and materials.

Mural project pieces must be done by **August 31, 2022**.

**Policies**

Artists will retain the ownership of the design ideas submitted with their application. Upon signing of a contract between the artist(s) and Silver City MainStreet, the ownership of the design and the artwork produced for this project will become the property of the Town of Silver City.

**Application Requirements**

- A narrative and design illustrating the concept of the proposal. Provide all information regarding the proposed artwork such as actual dimensions and materials to be used.
